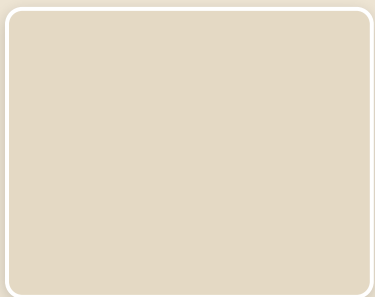

DESIGN CONCEPT

Warm Minimalist Layered in Lighting

The unit is designed around continuous cove lighting, honed travertine-look surfaces, and natural oak tones that carry from the kitchen through to the bedrooms. Every room shares the same restrained material palette, so the apartment reads as one composed space rather than a series of disconnected rooms.

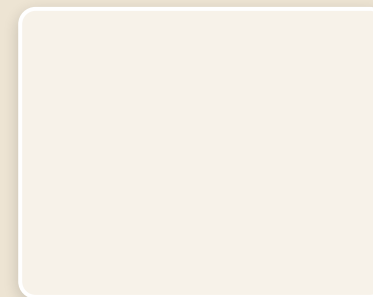

01 — KITCHEN

Open Kitchen & Staircase Landing

An L-shaped kitchen in matte cream and warm oak cabinetry, anchored by a full-height Samsung fridge and Bosch built-in oven and microwave column. A backlit open shelf breaks up the run of upper cabinets, and continuous under-cabinet and toe-kick lighting keeps the space glowing after dark.

02 — LIVING ROOM

Double-Height Living Room

Floor-to-ceiling glazing frames the Dubai skyline, while a backlit fluted feature column and a large abstract canvas anchor the media wall. A low floating console keeps the wall visually light, and the curved staircase carries the material language of stone and warm oak up to the next level.

04 — GUEST BATHROOM

Powder Room

A backlit circular mirror and a stone vessel basin set the tone for the guest bathroom, paired with brushed bronze fittings and a fluted tile accent behind the WC. Warm cove lighting along the ceiling and floor lines gives the compact room a spa-like glow.

07 — CORRIDOR

Gallery Hallway Corridor

The connecting corridor doubles as a private gallery, with large-format art pieces lit by continuous ceiling and floor coves. Walnut wardrobe joinery on one side balances the light stone flooring, tying the hallway back to the kitchen and living areas at either end.

06 — DRESSING ROOM

Walk-In Closet _Bedroom

A boutique-style dressing room in rich walnut joinery, with open shelving for bags and accessories lit individually to create a retail-display effect. A full-length mirror at the end of the run doubles the sense of depth, while a soft runner rug keeps the space warm underfoot.

03 — MASTER BEDROOM

Primary Bedroom with Skyline View

An upholstered headboard wall in soft grey is framed by ribbed wood panelling and cove lighting, facing a full-height window wall over the city. A floating oak media console and matching nightstands keep the floor open, echoing the same warm-oak and travertine palette used throughout the unit.

05 — EN-SUITE BATHROOM

Master En-Suite & Walk-In Shower

A frameless glass walk-in shower sits beside a floating stone vanity with a matching vessel basin, unified by the same brushed bronze fixtures and backlit round mirror as the powder room. A recessed niche with cove lighting adds a quiet, hotel-suite feel to the everyday routine.
